

## More than 900 homes sold in Rockingham County in 2019, a 5 percent increase from the previous year

ROCKINGHAM COUNTY, N.C. – There were 943 homes sold in Rockingham County in 2019, an increase of 5.2 percent from the previous year.

The monthly housing supply dropped to 2.9 months, a decrease of 31 percent from 2018, according to yearly statistics released this month by Triad MLS.

The median sales price for a Rockingham County home in 2019 was \$134,695, a 12.3 percent increase from 2018 and a 28.9 percent increase from 2015.
