GREENSBORO, N.C. – The Greensboro Regional REALTORS® Association has donated \$3,500 to Anna Freiberg to help feed the homeless during her Benders Tavern Annual Christmas Day Feast.

The check was presented during GRRRA’s annual luncheon on Tuesday, Dec. 3 at GRRRA at 23 Oak Branch Drive in Greensboro.

Freiberg owns Benders Tavern at 4517 W. Market St. in Greensboro and hosts an annual Christmas feast that offers food for the homeless on Christmas Day.
