There were 174 new home listings in that area during 2020's third quarter, according to statistics released by Triad MLS. That's an increase of 38.1 percent compared to the third quarter of 2019.

There were also 147 homes sold during the third quarter, an increase of 28.9 percent when compared to the same time last year.

The average sales price has seen a 14.6 percent increase to \$479,148.

The housing supply has dropped 37.8 percent to 2.8 months.
